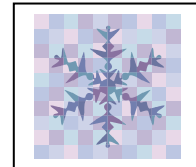

Do we have your correct phone numbers? If you are not receiving the automated phone calls at 6:00 every Sunday, we do not have a good phone number set up for you in the system. If you are not getting the calls, please send a note to the front office with the best number to reach you in case of an emergency and any other numbers you would like us to keep on file for your students.

Daily Arrival

Students must be in their seats and ready to work by 8:42 each morning or they will be marked tardy. (3 tardies equal one day absent) The first bell rings at 8:37 a.m. but students may be dropped off to go to the playground any time after 8:20 each day. When the weather requires it, students will be allowed to enter the building at 8:20 a.m. instead of going to the playground.

Daily Dismissal

Students are dismissed at 3:36 p.m. every day. Students picked up earlier than that will be marked tardy for the afternoon. (Again, 3 tardies equal 1 day absent)

Traffic Around the School

Please remember that there is no parking in front of the school on the school side of the street. That area is for pick up and drop off only. If you park there, you hold up the whole process of arrival and dismissal. You may park across from the school either in front along Hemingway or along the side on Westfield. Also please note that parking in the intersections is illegal. This can cause traffic tie ups or may impede vision for other drivers or students walking through that intersection. You may be ticketed or towed at your own expense. Please be aware of and courteous to other drivers and our students. We must protect the safety of all.



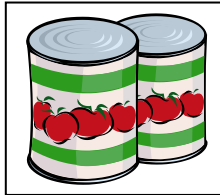
Parking or Traffic Issues
